Add Layout Sheet Sets to Building Styles...

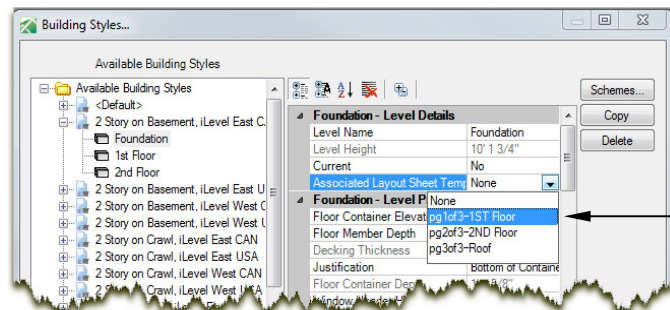
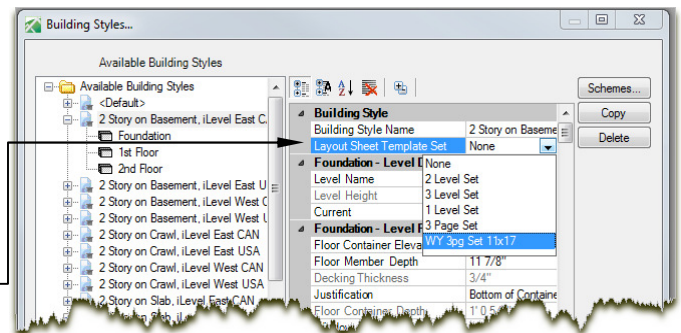
Take the extra steps out of your layout sheets on every job! With the release of **Javelin version 5.2** the Building Style... now can create the layout sheet when you start the job.

- Use your existing library of sheet sets to create All Layout Sheets when starting a job.
- The viewport will set visibility switches to the level specified.
- No need to add layout sheets into the job later.

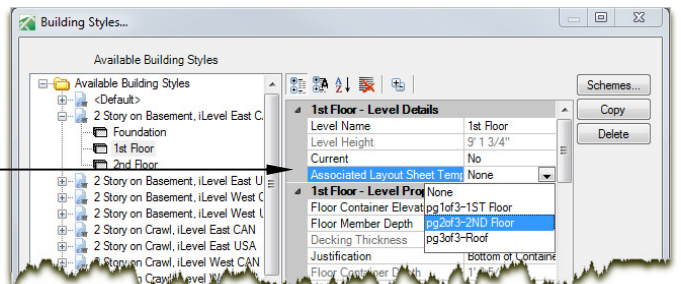
These steps will help update your existing **Building Styles...** You may need to refer to JET14006-Using.Job.Information and JET14007-Creating.Layout.Sheet.Sets. Once your Sheet Set is defined you can assign it to a Building Style...

Steps:

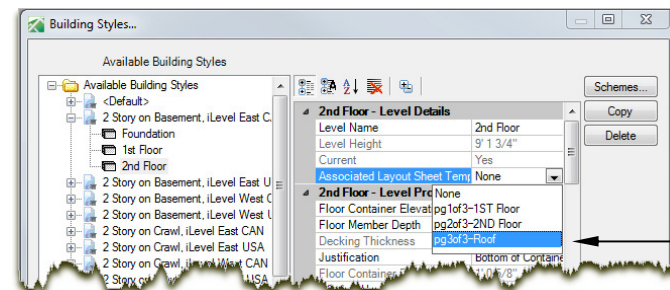
1. Open Javelin, **Setup > Building Styles...**
2. Select the desired Building Style... (*2 Storey on Basement...*) expand the tree to make selections easier.
3. Select the **Layout Sheet Template Set** from the list available (*WY 3pg Set 11x17*).



4. Select the first level (*Foundation*). Pick the **Associated Layout Sheet Template** from the list (*pg1of3-1ST Floor*).



5. Select the next level (*1st Floor*). Pick the **Associated Layout Sheet Template** from the list (*pg2of3-2ND Floor*).



6. Select the next level (*2nd Floor*). Pick the **Associated Layout Sheet Template** from the list (*pg3of3-Roof*).

7. Repeat Steps 2 through 6 for additional **Building Styles...** Click OK when complete.

Test your new **Building Style...** by creating a New Job and using it; you should see your layout sheets in the Job Tree under Layout Sheets.
